



EnerGaïa 2022: record attendance

Sponsored by the Occitanie / Pyrénées Méditerranée Regional Authority, Forum EnerGaïa, a major event for the renewable energy sector for the past 16 years, has reported unprecedented results for its 2022 show, with **370 exhibitors**, nearly **50 nations represented** (Germany, China, Spain, the Netherlands, Belgium among others) and **the attendance of more than 13,000 professionals**. This represents a two-figure increase on last year, at a time of a particularly acute climate and energy crisis.

Nearly 230 speakers contributed their insight into the key issues of the various renewable energy segments. Out of the hundred or so talks and round tables laid on, those dealing with the recycling of photovoltaic modules or agrivoltaics took place in front of a full house. The economic aspect of renewable energy was meanwhile addressed during interviews that took place throughout the two-day duration of the Forum.
