ENERGAÏA 2023: The definitive gathering for professionals, with ALL forms of renewable energy

The only trade show in France that deals with all renewables, EnerGaïa will be held on Wednesday 13 and Thursday 14 December in **Montpellier**. The event, which has doubled in size in the space of two years, will this year welcome more than 14,000 professionals, 400 exhibitors and nearly 100 talks, round tables, workshops and pitches from key experts in the sector, addressing the new energy challenges in France and abroad.

With solar PV, floating solar, offshore wind, renewable heat, biogas, hydrogen and agrivoltaics, the most recent technologies, the latest developments, initiatives and shared experiences will be presented to professionals in search of tangible solutions.

The **building** and **transport** sectors account for a significant proportion of energy consumption that industry, businesses and local authorities are seeking to control. Once again this year, these two fundamental sectors will have dedicated pavilions (Hall B1) in addition to the exhibitor offering.

Top-level talks and panel discussions on all the forms of renewable energy

Several of the highlights from among the talks proposed this year at EnerGaïa:

<u>Opening plenary</u>: "Young people and businesses at the heart of the transition: improving how we live and work tomorrow."

<u>Talks on solar PV</u>: "Floating photovoltaic, a new sector emerges", "Agrivoltaics: successfully marrying solar and agriculture", "Collective self-consumption and energy communities, a local dynamic", "PV carports, multipurpose solar", "Rebuilding the European photovoltaic industry, the challenge."

<u>And also</u>: "Renewables and biodiversity: reducing environmental impact during the operation of farms", "The decarbonisation of inter-urban public transport", "Floating offshore wind power in the Mediterranean to 2050: from planning to R&D", "Acceleration of renewable energy", "Forests and climate change, what resources for wood fuel?" "Green hydrogen: the time of major projects", "The circular economy of wind turbines" ...

Expert companies in the renewables sector will be given a platform in the form of "exhibitor pitches". Among the themes addressed: "The self-consumption rush" (by Likewatt), "Agrivoltaics: how to adapt the sizing of the project to agricultural practices: case study of row crops (Agrosolutions), "Community energy projects in support of short energy circuits" (Serenysun energies), "Plan, connect, oprimise; how the renewable energy acceleration Act is being deployed" (Enedis), "Developing is good, additionally protecting biodiverity is better" (Cemater).
